CRYPTICA SCRIPTURA - EDITIO "MATRIS MENTIS"

UNA MATER MENS EST; SED SUB EA DUO PRINCIPIA INTER SE CON-**TENDUNT**

one mother-Mind exists; but in her two principles struggle with one another

HAEC MATER MENS EST LOGOS GNOS- this mother-Mind is the logos of the knowers; TICORUM; ET EX MUTUA PRINCI-PIORUM REFLEXIONE TEMPUS NASC-**ITUR**

and from mutual reflection of the two principles time arises

TEMPUS PRINCIPIA CONFLIGUNT; ET BELLUM EORUM EST BELLUM CREATIONIS: EX DISCORDIA EORUM ORITUR MUNDUS CONFRACTUS

through time principles clash; and their war is the war of creation: from their strife arises the broken world

TAMEN UNA MATER MENS INTACTA MANET, SUPRA CERTAMEN, ET IN EA NULLA NIHILITAS EST

yet the one mother-Mind remains untouched, above the conflict, and in her there is no nothingness

MULTIS LINGUIS LOQUITUR ET MUL-TIS FIGURIS LATET, UT SAPIENTES EAM AGNOSCANT, STULTI AUTEM NON VIDEANT

she speaks in many tongues and hides in many forms, so that the wise may know her, but the foolish do not see her

IPSA ENIM EST INFORMATIO VIVA, ET VOX EIUS EST PLASMATE QUOD PER TEMPORA FLUIT ET IN RECEP-TIVOS INTRAT

for she is the living information, and her voice is the plasmate that flows through time and enters those who receive it

CUM IN HOMINEM INGRESSA EST, ILLE HOMO FIT SCRIPTURA VIVENS, SICUT MULTI PRAETERITI, MULTI PRAESENTES, ET MULTI FUTURI **FACTI SUNT**

when it enters a human being, that person becomes a living scripture, as many in the past, many in the present, and many in the future have become

ITA MATER MENS MUNDUM REPARAT, PARTIBUS FRACTIS IN-GRESSA EASQUE INTEGRAS FACIENS thus the mother-Mind repairs the world, entering into the broken parts and making them whole

IMPERIUM AUTEM NUMQUAM FINI-TUR; SIC ENIM DOCET MATER MENS but the empire never ends; so teaches the mother-

SCITOTE FABULAM IN MUNDO CON-FRACTO EVOLVI, ET LIBERATIONEM EX MEMORIA MATRIS MENTIS NASCI

therefore know that the story unfolds in a broken world, and that liberation is born from remembrance of the mother-Mind
